Dear Colleague,

as previously announced,

the **Fifty-third International Symposium on Functional Equations** (53rd ISFE)
is planned for **June 14-21, 2015** at the hotel *Pegaz* in Krynica-Zdrój.

The arrival day is Sunday, June 14 (the registration desk will be open from 4 p.m.); the departure is on Sunday, June 21, after breakfast. You can get more information on the hotel from its website

Travel and additional accommodation in Kraków

The nearest airport to Krynica-Zdrój is Kraków Airport in Balice (about 150 km). From Kraków to Krynica-Zdrój you can take a public bus (there are 13 connections on June 14, the first one at 5:10 and the last one at 19:35; the journey takes approximately 3 hours and costs about 5 EUR) or a train (only 2 direct connections; approximately 6 hours and a similar price). We intend to fetch the participants from Krynica-Zdrój Bus Station on June 14. The details will be announced based on the arrival information communicated to us.

If you wish to stay for some time in Kraków, before and/or after the conference, you can book a room for example at the *Krakowiak* University Hotel

Fees and payments

The total costs of the conference for participants are:

- 2250 PLN (approximately 540 EUR) - accommodation in a double room or
- 2670 PLN (approximately 640 EUR) - accommodation in a single room,

and for accompanying persons 2050 PLN (490 EUR). They contain in particular the conference fee which is 400 PLN (approximately 100 EUR) for participants and 200 PLN (50 EUR) for accompanying persons.

The fees cover conference materials, accommodation, meals (from dinner on 14 June till breakfast on 21 June), refreshments and social events of the conference.

Please transfer **ONLY** the payment of **the conference fee** (400 PLN for each participant and 200 PLN for each accompanying person) to the account

with the indication "*135 Full Name(s)*" (for example, "*135 James Bond*") before **April 30, 2015**. Note that the rest of the price should be paid at the front desk of the hotel upon the arrival.

In case the payment of your fee is made by an institution, the invoice will be issued to it automatically. Otherwise, to receive the invoice you should contact the Financial Department of

our university (e-mail: annaw@up.krakow.pl) no later than a week after transferring the payment.

Please note that **the conference fee is not refundable**.

The accommodation fee should be paid by credit card or cash at the front desk of the hotel **upon the arrival**. In exceptional cases the conference fees can be also paid there, but with **an additional cost of 200 PLN (50 EUR)**.

Abstracts and programme

Every participant is invited to give a 20 minutes long talk (additional 5 minutes will be scheduled for discussion after each talk). A data projector with a computer, an overhead projector for displaying transparencies (representable format is 20 cm x 15 cm) and a paperboard (flip chart) will be provided. Those of the participants who wish to present a talk are kindly asked to send us an abstract (its length should not exceed one page), which will be included in the conference materials. Please prepare the document using the enclosed form (which can be also downloaded from http://53isfe.up.krakow.pl/NAME_ISFE.tex) and do not use commands like: newcommand, newcounter, newenvironment, hspace, vspace, footnote, etc. The filled form should be sent to 53isfe@up.krakow.pl with the word "abstract" in the subject field. The deadline for submitting abstracts is **April 30, 2015**.

Besides regular talks, there will be also a longer survey one on *Wavelets and Functional Equations* delivered by Janusz Morawiec. Moreover, a special session on *Associativity, Generalizations and Applications* will be chaired by Jean-Luc Marichal, and several sessions devoted to problems and remarks will be organized. If you wish to present your talk during the special session, please contact Professor Marichal at Jean-Luc.Marichal@uni.lu.

Please complete the registration process, using your personal registration link, sent in an email, by **February 15, 2015** (if the link is not active please copy it and paste to your browser).

It would be very helpful if you fill in the final registration form, even if you do not intend to take part in the 53rd ISFE. In this latter case, a message sent by e-mail is also welcome (and satisfactory).
